LECTURER POSITION

The *Department of Civil, Environmental, and Construction Engineering* (CECE) of the University of Central Florida (UCF), Orlando, invites applications for one Lecturer position to start August 2010. Of particular interest are candidates who will support the department's teaching mission. The minimum qualification is a Masters degree in Civil, Environmental, or Construction engineering. Prior university-level teaching experience, Professional Engineering registration, and a Ph.D. in engineering are preferred. Responsibilities of the successful candidate include teaching mainly the undergraduate courses in the broad areas of Civil, Environmental, and Construction engineering. The position is a non-tenured 9-month academic appointment. A two-year employment agreement can be offered.

With more than 1,000 undergraduate and 150 graduate students, the Department offers doctoral and masters programs in Civil and Environmental Engineering, and ABET-accredited bachelor's programs in Civil, Environmental, and Construction Engineering. The instructional and research activities are conducted by over 18 tenured/tenure-track faculty members.
